Aspiring Architect Scholarship

Scholarship Awards

- Two \$1,000 Scholarships for 1st year Undergraduate studies
- One \$1,000 Scholarship for Graduate studies

Eligibility

Undergraduates

- Applicant must be a Ventura County Resident and 2011 High School Graduate **OR** A full-time student (12 units or more) at a community college located within Ventura County. (See a list of community colleges in Ventura County at www.vcccd.edu)
- Applicant must be a 1st year student at an accredited architecture school in the 2011 Winter semester. (See which schools are accredited at www.naab.org)

Graduates

- Applicant must be a Ventura County Resident
- Applicant must be a student in a Masters Degree program at an accredited architecture school in the 2011 Fall semester. (See which schools are accredited at www.naab.org)

Application Requirements

- Complete the attached application form
- A sealed official copy of current academic transcripts
- A statement about your goals as an aspiring architect (1,000 -1,500 words)
- Submit three letters of recommendation, one from each of the following:
 - Current Teacher
 - Advisor, Coach, Pastor, or other Extra Curricular Leader
 - Someone not related to you from the Community
- Submit a portfolio (8-1/2 x 11 max) of architectural drawings, artwork, photographs, etc. At a minimum include one freehand sketch of your favorite building in Ventura County and up to ten examples of your best work. Please **DO NOT** send originals, materials cannot be returned.

Selection Process

Recipients will be selected by a committee comprised of members of the AIA Ventura County Chapter.
